## <u>Literacy</u>

• TASK 1: Write a set of instructions to make Easter chocolate crispy cakes

Year 1 Write a set of numbered instructions in the correct order using a verb at the beginning of each new instruction eg stir, whisk, bake

Year 2 Write a set of numbered instructions in the correct order using a time connective and verb at the beginning of each new instruction eg First weigh, next mix, then cut

- TASK 2: Look at a range of different recipes discussing ingredients, how the recipe is set out, the use of verbs and time words
- TASK 3: Watch Big Cook Little Cook and discuss recipes

# <u>RE</u>

- TASK 1: Read the Easter Story and re-tell orally. Draw a picture, create a storymap of make a scene from the Easter Story using Lego or play dough
- TASK 2: Re-write the Easter story focusing on punctuation

### **Geography**

- Set up an Easter Egg hunt either inside or in your garden
- Firstly, give children a set of oral clues using prepositions eg in front, behind, underneath etc
- Then use left, right, clockwise, anticlockwise
- Then use North, East, South, West and compass midpoints

### <u>Maths</u>

- TASK 1: Measures
- Discuss grams, kilograms and millilitres and litres in terms of a recipe
- Give your children lots of opportunities to measure different things using weighing scales and measuring jugs
