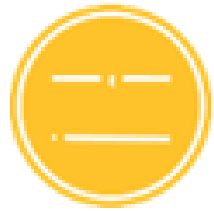


This is how Mrs Martin followed the Sentence Stacking lesson and wrote her sentences for plot point 2.



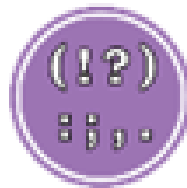
Sentence Structure:
