





Name of place: Antarctica	
<b>CONTINENT –</b> Which continent is it in?	<p>Antarctica</p> <p>Antarctica is a continent. The South Pole is found in Antarctica. It is at the bottom of the world. Antarctica is the fifth largest continent and most of it is covered in ice.</p> 
<b>OCEANS AND SEAS –</b> Which oceans or seas are nearby?	<p>The Southern Ocean</p> <p>The Southern Ocean, sometimes known as the Antarctic Ocean, is the fourth largest ocean. Icebergs are found in The Southern Ocean and there are often very dangerous winds there too.</p> 
<b>WEATHER –</b> What is the weather like there? Is it hot or cold there? Is it near the equator or the poles?	<p>It is very cold in Antarctica – it is the coldest continent of all and it is covered in ice. It can be very windy in Antarctica but it can also be very sunny. Antarctica only has summer and winter. It doesn't rain or snow very much in Antarctica.</p> 
<b>WHO AND WHAT –</b> Who lives there? Which animals and plant live there?	<p>In the summer between 1000 and 5000 people, mostly scientists, live in Antarctica.</p> <p>Antarctic sea life includes penguins, blue whales, orcas, colossal squids and fur seals. Algae and Fungi also live in Antarctica.</p>

Antarctica is covered in a thick layer of ice. You would also see snow and rocky mountains, including some volcanoes. You would also see places where humans live.
