Example:

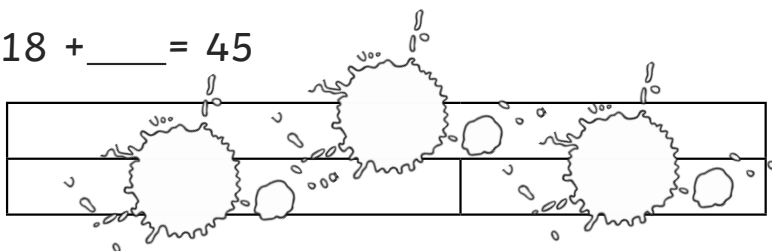
$$24 + \quad = 49$$

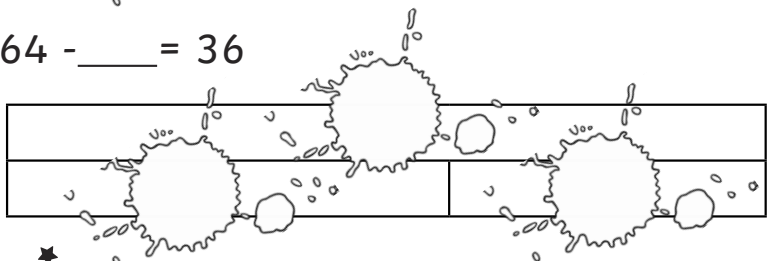
I know $49 - 24 = 25$.

I can check this with facts families: $25 + 24 = 49$, $24 + 25 = 49$, $49 - 25 = 24$.

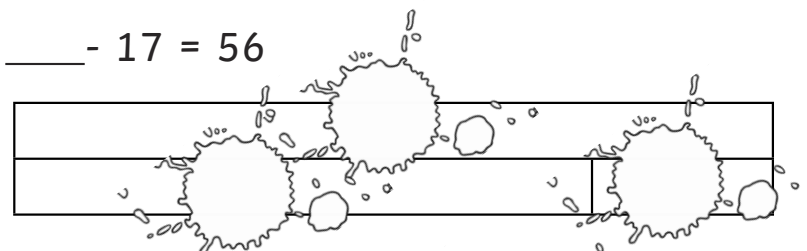

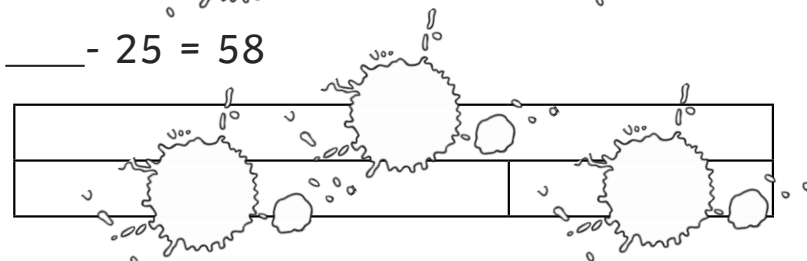
