1. We are going to think about a group of people called Christians. What is their special symbol?

To help them live their best life, many Christians follow some rules from the Bible called the 10 Commandments.

Have a look at the 10 Commandments document. Create your own poster of the 10 Commandments but write any commandments that you don't understand in your own words.

* <u>Diving Deeper Challenge</u>: Are any of these rules tricky in your opinion? Discuss this with your grown ups.

2. Somebody has written to their Christian friend, Abi, asking for help. Have a look at what they have written.

Dear Abi

I have a problem. I am so tempted to steal a scarf from my brother. It has the England Football Team logo on it and it is really soft and long - perfect for a cold winter! Do you think it would be ok if I stole it?

From Bill

Write what Abi might reply to Bill. Link your answer to the 10 Commandments. What do the 10 Commandments say about this situation?

* Diving Deeper Challenge: What would you say to Bill? Is it the same as what you think Abi would say?

3. Christians also have a story from the Bible about what happens when people break rules. Have a read of this? What things did the characters do wrong?

* <u>Diving Deeper Challenge</u>: This story is retold in a slightly different way depending on what Bible or website you read it from. See if you can read this story from another Bible or website. Is it exactly the same as the first one you read?

- 4. Answer these questions about the story Paradise Lost that you read in the last task.
- a) What was the rule that Adam and Eve broke? (1 mark)
- b) What was Adam and Eve's punishment? (1 mark)
- c) What are the names of the two humans in this story? (2 marks)

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| 5. Look at the Planning Sheet Document . Complete this about Paradise Lost, the Bible story of Adam and Eve eating the apple. This will help you when we come to retell the story later on. Feel free to add pictures and colour! |
| * <u>Diving Deeper Challenge:</u> Use the Concept Lightbulbs Document to help you think about what themes there are in the story. |
| 6. Look at the Ellipsis Document. Recreate this poster in your own way. |
| * Diving Deeper Challenge: See if you can find an example of an ellipsis in a book you are reading. |

7. Use all of your work so far to help you write the story of Paradise Lost - the story of Adam and Eve eating the apple. You could use three paragraphs; one for the beginning of the story, one for the middle and one for the end.

- 8. Look at your piece of writing. Add a sentence to the end of each paragraph which uses an ellipsis. This will help add tension and suspense to your writing!
