<p>The child is watching the sea and the horizon. What does he see?</p> <p>How is the sea behaving? What is the sky like? Vocabulary: Dark water Churning Heaving Clouds looming Cliffs Disturbed shadows</p> 	<p>My eyes scanned the horizon where the sea churned and heaved, dark shadow-filled waves lurching under a gloomy, looming sky.</p>	<p>Pupils experiment with language to write a sentence about what the child sees just before the Viking ship appears. The sentence/s should be ominous suggesting something bad is coming.</p> <p>Add a sentence to link this first sentence to the one described below.</p> <p>e.g. And then I saw it. A ship. An unfamiliar type of ship.</p>	
<p>List of Three Eg Neil Gaiman sentence describing a fox: Its muzzle was narrow, its ears were pricked and sharp, and its expression was calculating and sly.</p> <p>Discuss the use of adjectives and precise language eg muzzle and expression.</p> <p>Precise language for the Viking ship = bow, stern, sail, mast, figurehead</p> 	<p>Its bow was curved, its body was slender and shallow, and the figurehead was both intimidating and beautiful.</p>	<p>Pupils use the same structure as Neil Gaiman to describe the ship.</p>	



### Simile

Describe the figurehead as seen from a distance.

Remember you can't see the carved detail yet.

#### Vocabulary

Dragon / sea-serpent

Neck

Curved

Sinuous

Snake-like

Sea fog, mist

#### Different approaches to similes:

Comparing what the figurehead looks like to something similar;

Comparing the way the boat moves to a similar action.

Remember the comparison has to be from Viking times e.g. it can't move like a motorbike or look like a Pokemon!

Moving sinuously through the sea-fog, the dragon's head pushed forward, slicing through the waves like an axe splitting wood.
