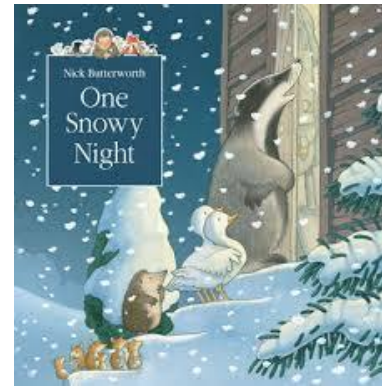


Apple and Lime Home Learning

Week Commencing – 4-1-2021

One Snowy Night



This week we are focusing on the story 'One Snowy Night' by Nick Butterworth. You can listen to the story using the link below:

Monday:

Phonics – Introducing the Letter J (use the attached Phase 3 Letters and Sounds PDF) just look at J. Ask the children to write all of the words they can think of that start with the letter J. They can then write the following sentence 'I can jump'. Some of the children will need to be reminded about spaces, asked to write one word at a time and need an alphabet mat (attached), and a phase 2 tricky word mat (attached).

Write Stuff – The children have been writing daily since their first day – they call this brave writing. They use the EYFS Rainbow from the Write Stuff Approach. The EYFS Rainbow is attached. Watch the story – then encourage your child to think of the missing words for the sentences below. The first sentence is a 'feeling' fantastic and the second is a 'noticing' one – I have given some examples. They do not need to write the whole sentence, just their chosen missing words.



Percy put on his _____ (warm boots, cosy socks, snuggly scarf)



In Percy's hut it is _____ and _____ (warm and dry, cosy and warm)

I have attached these sentences as 'One Snowy Night PDF' – it has all of the writing for the week, they would normally use a flipchart in class, but it gives you an idea of the format, however it does not need to be printed and can be on plain or lined paper.

Maths – This week we are focusing on addition and subtraction within 10. Please use the following lessons from Oak National Academy.

Phonics – Introducing the letter V – exactly as yesterday, but include a quick recap for the letter J. The sentence they can write is: ‘The man is in a van.’

Phonics – Letter W. Recap J and V and they can write the sentence ‘ A pig in a wig.’

Phonics – Letter X. Recap previous days and write ‘A fox in a box.’

Friday:

Phonics – Letter y. Recap previous 4 days and write ‘Yes I can go.’

Write Stuff – Friday is a non-fiction day, and the children can use one of the final two pages to label the winter clothes. If a printer is unavailable, please ask the children to draw their own picture and label it with 4 items of winter clothing.

Other Activities:

Physical – Cut and sort the winter and summer clothes – I have attached a PDF for this; however, you could also use catalogues and if these are not available then the children can make snowflakes – we are working on improving our scissor skills.

Creative -

Colour a scarf to make a repeating pattern.
