Reading

Try and read every day to an adult this week. Share a story together and talk about the front cover, what you think the story will be about, the main character, where the story is set and things that happen in the story. Do you think you can try and predict how the story will end?

Geography

We are starting a new learning experience called Town Planners where the learning focus is about Settlements. We will start this four-week learning experience by using a sequence of Geography lessons on the Oak National Academy website which we would like your child to follow. Once the Oak National Academy lessons have been completed, after the first two weeks of this learning experience, we will be asking you and your child to undertake some local fieldwork in the streets where you live. This will include a traffic survey, understanding which are essential and non-essential shops and looking at local services including public transport, Doctor's and dental surgeries, recycling facilities and local schools and libraries.
