

## Year 1 and 2 Home Learning Week Commencing 25th January 2021

### Reading

Try and read every day to an adult this week. Share a story together and talk about the front cover, what you think the story will be about, the main character, where the story is set and things that happen in the story. Do you think you can try and predict how the story will end?

### Geography

We are continuing with our learning experience called Town Planners where the learning focus is about Settlements. We will carry on using the sequence of Geography lessons on the Oak National Academy website which we would like your child to follow. Once you have completed the Oak National Academy lessons, after the first two weeks of this learning experience, we will be asking you and your child to undertake some local fieldwork in the streets where you live. This will include a traffic survey, understanding which shops are essential and non-essential and looking at local services including public transport, Doctor's and dental surgeries, recycling facilities and local schools and libraries.

## Geography

### Task 1

#### LO I understand what makes up a city

### Task 3

#### LO I can identify what human and physical features I can find in my settlement?

In this lesson, we will be exploring the difference between human and physical features of a settlement. You will get a chance to see Mr Hutchinson exploring his settlement to look for these features, then you will have the opportunity to investigate your own settlement!

#### LO I can sketch a map of my settlement
