

I stepped onto the Golden Gate Bridge.

Examples

Add adjectives and/or adverbs

I stepped <u>tentatively</u> anto the Golden Gate Bridge.

Add an –ing clause or –ed clause at the beginning Looking around in awe and wonder, I stepped tentatively onto the Golden Gate Bridge.

Add personification

Looking around in awe and wonder, I stepped tentatively onto the Golden Gate Bridge; its giant arms reaching out before me. (Note the use of a semicolon)

Add a simile which begins 'making me feel like' Looking around in awe and wonder, I stepped tentatively anto the Golden Gate Bridge; its giant arms reaching out before me, making me feel like a child in a parent's arms.

Add an adjective or adverb anywhere within the sentence

Looking around in awe and wonder, I stepped tentatively onto the Golden Gate Bridge; its giant arms reaching out before me, making me feel like an inquisitive child in a parent's arms.
