<p>Handwriting (horizontal joins to ascenders this week) – practise <i>ol</i> Write it 6 times, Make sure the join starts on the line for each letter. Write the word <i>old</i>, again making sure each letter join starts on the line.</p> <p>Spelling – Choose 2 Year 2 Common Exception words (see list at bottom). Learn to spell these words.</p> <p>Focus – Suffix ly</p> <p>'ly' changes nouns (naming words) into time adverbials such as week- weekly, month- monthly etc</p> <p>Add the suffix ly to these time adverbials:</p>	<p>Handwriting – practise <i>wh</i>. Write it 6 times, Make sure the join starts on the line for each letter. Write the word <i>what</i>, again making sure each letter join starts on the line.</p> <p>Spelling – Choose 2 Year 2 Common Exception words (see list at bottom). Learn to spell these words.</p> <p>Focus – Suffix ly</p> <p>'ly' which changes nouns (naming word) into adjectives (describing word) such as friend – friendly, mother – motherly.</p>	<p>Handwriting – practise <i>ot</i>. Write it 6 times, Make sure the join starts on the line for each letter. Write the word <i>otter</i>, again making sure each letter join starts on the line.</p> <p>Spelling – Choose 2 Year 2 Common Exception words (see list at bottom).
