The Romans were in Britain before the Anglo Saxons so it is important to know why they left before we learn why the Anglo Saxons came. The final slide asks you to fill in the <b>Blank Map</b>. You can use the slides and the other pictures of the <b>Roman Empire Maps</b> to help you.</p>
