Reading

Try and read every day to an adult this week. Share a story together and talk about the front cover, what you think the story will be about, the main character, where the story is set and things that happen in the story. Do you think you can try and predict how the story will end?

Geography

We are continuing with our learning experience called Town Planners.

We will be using this week to complete our fieldwork about our local settlement. This fieldwork will take place in Borough Green and around the streets where you live. You will be answering some questions about Borough Green, drawing a map of the village, adding symbols to your map and creating a key. Then you will use Google maps to pinpoint your house and finally you will learn about the directions North, East, South and West as they appear on the points of a compass.

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Geography

Task 1

LO I can answer questions about my local area

We would like you to take a *Geography* fieldtrip around *Borough Green*. Before you set off, please have a look at the *Geography* questionnaire below. This will help you to decide which parts of *Borough Green* you need to visit. The places you visit will also be helpful when you draw and add symbols to your map later in the week.

Use this opportunity to identify and talk about any human geography features you see and any physical geography features you see when you are out in *Borough Green*. You will also be looking at local services including different types of public transport, where you can post a letter or a parcel, the local library, the opticians and dentist's surgeries, the recycling facilities and *Borough Green* Park and playground.

We also want you to be aware of keeping safe when walking around the village and identifying safe places to cross the road and railway lines.

Geography Questionnaire

1. Visit the railway station in Borough Green. Where do the trains go?
2. Go and look at the recycling centre next to the station car park. What different things can you recycle here?
3. How can you get across the train track safely?
4. Can you catch a bus in Borough Green?
5. Where is it safe to cross the road outside Sainsbury's supermarket?
6. Where is it safe to cross the road on Western Road and on the High Street?
7. What times is the library usually open?
8. Is there a dentist in the High Street? Why would you go to the dentist?
9. Is there an optician in the High Street? Why would you go to the optician?
10. Name the different types of play equipment you can see in the playground at Borough Green Park.
11. How many churches are there in Borough Green? Can you name them?
12. Is there a Post Office in Borough Green?

Task 2

LO I can draw an aerial map of Borough Green and then add symbols and a key

Task 3

LO I can explore Google street maps and then learn about the importance of compass points

Ask an adult to help you get into Google maps. Ask them to put in your address/postcode and then trace your route to school. Remember to try out street view. Do you recognise the houses, shops and cafes? Look at the road layout and spot all the different types of road markings, pavements and street furniture including barriers, bins and post boxes.

Finally, finish the Town Planners experience by completing the final lesson on the Oak Academy website where you will learn all about compass points and how we use a compass to help us navigate a map. You will learn about the points on a compass - North, East, South and West.
