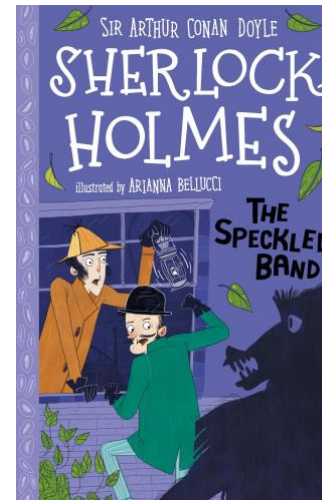

What Makes A Good Website?

<b>browser</b>	A computer program with a graphical user interface for displaying and navigating between web pages.	<b>logo</b>	A symbol or small design used to identify your product or brand.
<b>web page</b>	A hypertext document on the World Wide Web.	<b>audience</b>	The people the website is designed for.
<b>home page</b>	The introductory page of a website, typically serving as a table of contents for the site.	<b>purpose</b>	What your website is trying to do e.g. inform, persuade, entertain
<b>website</b>	A set of related web pages located under a single domain name, typically produced by a single person or organisation.	<b>software</b>	The programs that control or are run on a computer including the operating system, interpreters, compilers and application programs (apps).
<b>address bar</b>	A text box in a web browser displaying the address of the web page that is currently being viewed.	<b>copyright</b>	The law that protects an individual's work from being used without their permission.
<b>tabs</b>	A second or further document or page that can be opened on a spreadsheet or web browser.	<b>html</b>	Hypertext Markup Language
<b>media</b>	Text or images added to a web page.	<b>device</b>	A piece of portable electronic equipment that can connect to the internet.
