A message from the Governing Body

Dear Parents & Carers

Following the resignation of our former Headteacher (Mrs Sandberg) over the summer, Governors have been busy looking at the strategic options and best way forward for the school.

After a lengthy process to determine the best way forward, and following a report by the Strategic Direction Panel, in our meeting on 21st October 2023, Governors unanimously approved the decision to recruit a new substantive Headteacher for the school moving forwards.

Following the meeting, Governors have been busy meeting with the HR team and other relevant parties to prepare the person specification and vacancy advertising. This has also included meeting with the children to ensure their views are taken into consideration of what they value and want to see in a headteacher. The advert is due to go live on Friday 24th November 2023 and will close on 8th January 2024 with interviews due to take place in late January 2024.

To ensure we recruit the best possible candidate, we are recruiting for a start of either April 2024 (Summer Term) or to commence at the start of the Academic Year 2024-25.

To support the above process, we are pleased to announce that, should the best candidate <u>not</u> be in a position to commence until the next academic year, our Interim Headteacher, Mr Cooper, who was originally due to leave us at Easter 2024, will remain with us until the end of this academic year. If we find a suitable candidate for an April 2024 start, Mr Cooper will also still remain available to us to ensure a smooth transition and assist in tasks such as setting the new budgets and enabling the incoming headteacher to hit the ground running.

We will be in a position to update you further at the end of January 2024. Thank you for your patience in this matter.


