# What have the children been up to this week?

**NURSERY**: This week the children in the nursery have been busy practicing their nativity play and Christmas songs, getting creative with plenty of arts and crafts and sensory play - making sparkly pictures with lots of collage materials, and also exploring communication and sign language. Our toddlers have enjoyed signing different animal names, winter/ celebration words and other basic words such as 'mummy and daddy' and so on. They have really enjoyed themselves this week.

**FLO:** We have been fortunate this week to welcome Sophie Tibbles, the local support co-ordinator for Kent Young carers, to our school this week. She spoke to the children in assembly to tell them about what it means to be a Young Carer. She explained how young people can be helping to care for parents, siblings and other family members in lots of different ways, from helping with shopping and housework, to reading a book to help a sibling feel better. It is believed that there could be around 3 children in every class that care in some way for a family member and they often go unidentified. At Borough Green we only have six children currently registered as Young Carers but know there are probably many more. We are trialling running a Young carers group which provides children with the opportunity to talk about their feelings in an understanding environment and also gives them the opportunities to socialise with other Young carers and have some fun. Registering as a Young carer also gives families access to external support and opportunities that they may find difficult to access otherwise. ## Awards this week...


