


World Book Day 2024

World Book Day is on Thursday 7th March this year and we have lots of exciting things planned in school. We would like to continue the idea from last year for dressing up with the children coming in dressed up as a 'word'. They should not have the word written on them as they will be guessing what each other represents as part of one of their activities on the day. Some great ideas from last year included colours (children come in dressed in as one colour), adjectives such as 'cosy' (children coming in dressed in warm dressing gowns), sporty (wearing sports clothes) or coming in dressed as a particular animal.
