Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to update you on our search for the new Headteacher of Borough Green Primary School and are delighted to announce that Mrs Karen Jackson has been appointed. She will start her new role after the Easter holidays.

Following a two-day, rigorous recruitment process we found Mrs Jackson demonstrated all the qualities we were looking for. In particular, she quickly developed relationships with the children and staff through her open and warm character.

These personal qualities are underpinned by a depth of experience and professional knowledge. She has been in education for over 25 years and is currently Head of a two-form entry school with a nursery.

World Book Day.....


World Book Day 2024

World Book Day is on Thursday 7th March this year and we have lots of exciting things planned in school. We would like to continue the idea from last year for dressing up with the children coming in dressed up as a 'word'. They should not have the word written on them as they will be guessing what each other represents as part of one of their activities on the day. Some great ideas from last year included colours (children come in dressed in as one colour), adjectives such as 'cosy' (children coming in dressed in warm dressing gowns), sporty (wearing sports clothes) or coming in dressed as a particular animal. Please do not feel you need to buy outfits for the children - they can just use what they have at home!

We will be running a sponsored read from Monday 4th March to Sunday 11th March in conjunction with Usborne to raise money for new non-fiction books for the school library. Look out for the poster in the newsletter with information after half term.

Mo is the author of the Agent Moose series and will be leading some workshops with the children around graphic novels.
