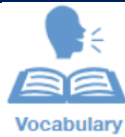

### Speak like an expert geographer:

**Antarctica:** a continent in the Antarctic region with a polar climate.

**glacier:** a river or mass of ice that is moving slowly and formed from compacted snow.

**carbon footprint:** the amount of carbon dioxide released into the atmosphere by one person, organisation or process.

**ice sheet:** a mass of glacial ice that covers the ground.

**topography:** the physical appearance of the natural features of an area of land.

**tundra:** an area of land where it is too cold for trees to grow and the ground below the surface is permanently frozen.
