Flying Fish

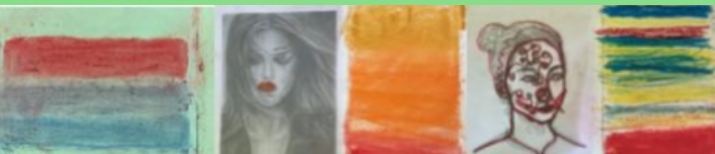
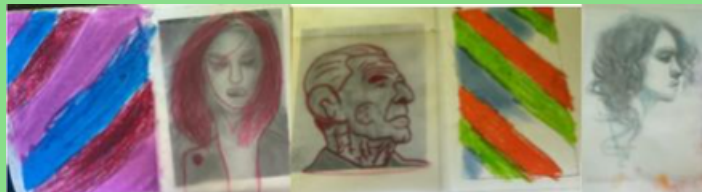

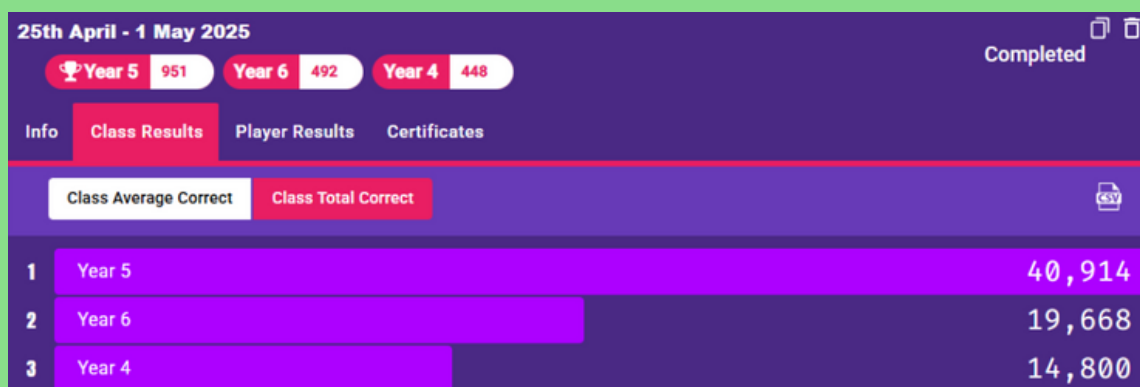
This week's attendance..
