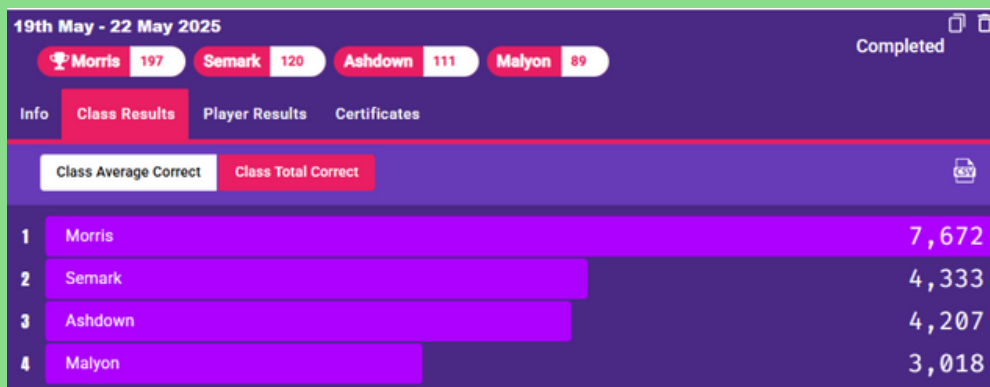
## Thank you...

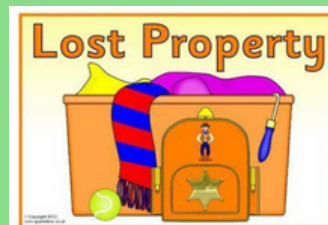


The total attendance so far this year is 93%,
