Woodland walks, tribe songs and dances, riddles and camp games - all guided by some brilliant and expert leaders, supported by our own intrepid teacher team!

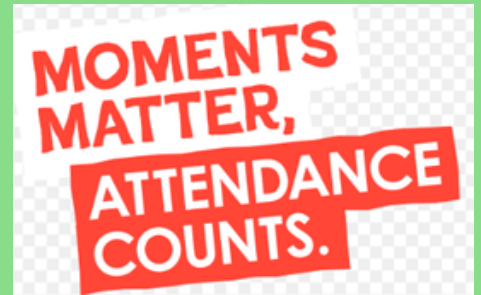

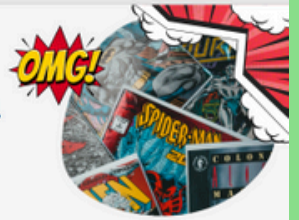
