Dear Parents and Carers,

Another busy week at Borough Green Primary School has flown by with lots of learning taking place in school. In Year One, the children have been inspired in their writing by the story of the Queen's Hat. Miss Lister tells me that she was so impressed with the progress in writing from Apple Class. Whilst covering the class for Mrs Hemsley on Wednesday morning, the children completed their writing lesson with increased skills and confidence-this is pleasing to hear.

The Year One children and the Year 4 children have been taking part in the national Phonics screening and Multiplication check and we are proud of their effort and determination.

I have seen some super writing by children in Poplar Class inspired by a mystery story about a riddle of the Sphinx. Their writing was suitably scary and created fear for me as a reader!

As we are in the warmer months, we are starting to look at playtime and lunch break activities and would like to create some activity zones around the meadow and playgrounds. We are going to focus on developing a zone at a time and will be requesting some support from you as parents. Our first zone for development is a 'dressing up zone.' If you have any dressing up costumes that have been grown out of or suitable clothing, for example: suit jackets, dresses, gloves, hats, themed onesies, or accessories, we can make use of them. Our dressing up zone will be popular with the children and they can make use of our stage and recently upgraded outdoor classroom.

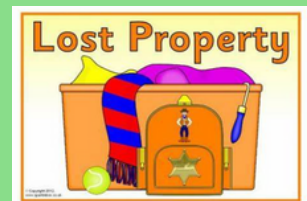
