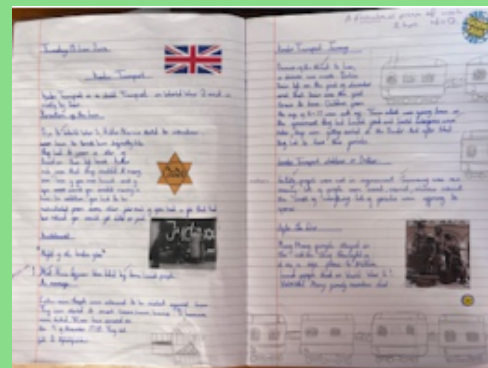

Enjoy the sunshine this weekend.

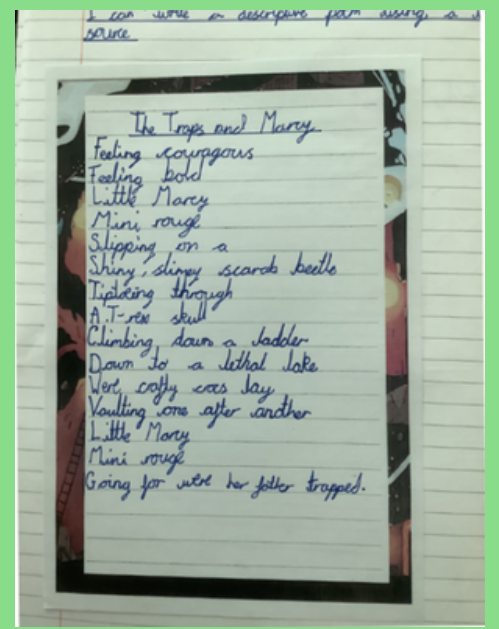
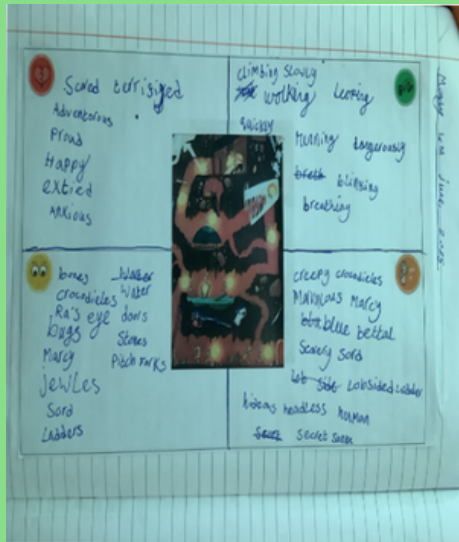

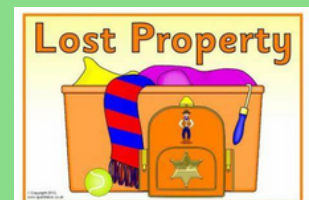
