## **Written Statement of Behaviour Principles**

We are determined that our child first, pupil second ethos permeates every aspect of school life. Our behaviour written statement is to be read in that light and in conjunction with the school behaviour policy, which is also available on our school website.

### **We want our school to be:**

- A happy school where children are healthy and safe in a caring and supportive environment
- Highly committed to the welfare, well-being and happiness of our children
- A place where all pupils and staff feel valued and respected
- A school focused on high expectations for behaviour and learning
- A warm, welcoming and inclusive school where communication is highly valued and everyone has a voice
- A no put-down zone, where children are cared for and cared about, and never ridiculed or belittled
- A school where we work closely in partnership with families to provide the best possible environment for the education of their children

### **We aim to:**

- Model and reward positive behaviours
- Have high expectations of all members of the school community
- Support children and families in the modification of negative behaviour
- Through appropriate behaviour, create an environment where active learning takes place
- Promote a secure and happy environment free from threat, harassment and any type of bullying behaviour
- Ensure that rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy

### **To that end:**

- Every member of Borough Green's Community will be valued, respected and welcomed equally
- Children will be taught to celebrate their differences, understand the cultural diversity and variances within their community; local and global
- All discrimination from any member of the school community to another will be tackled rigorously.

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.
